# Foundations of Technology

- Students enter grade 9 in the career/tech program to which they have been accepted;
- Students “rotate” to several other technology areas to complement what they learn in their chosen area;
- Successful completion of these rotations will award 1 credit toward graduation and meet the state requirement for technology education.
- \*\*Exception: Cyber Security : AP Computer Science will be their FOT credit

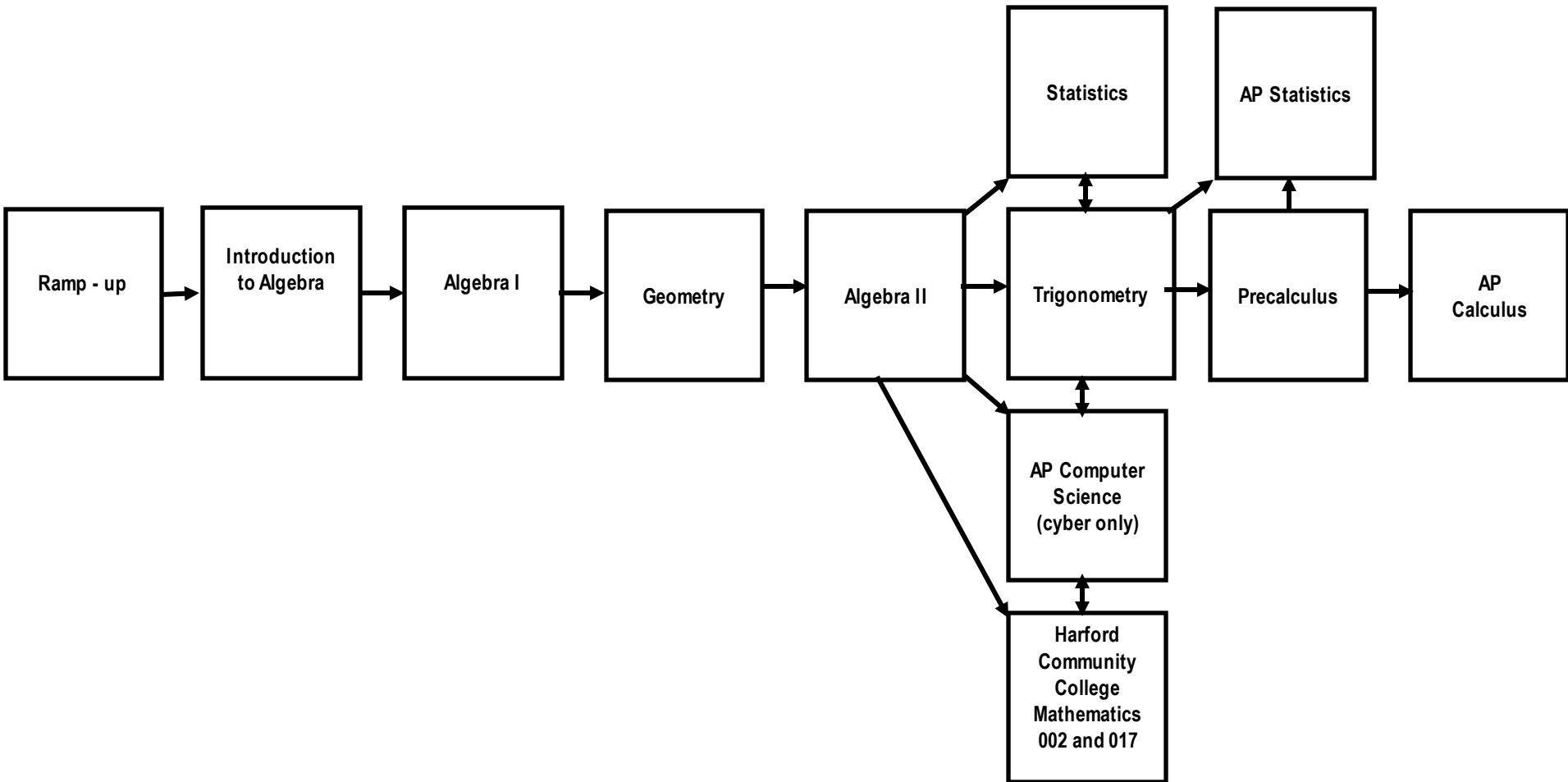
